Budget Billing

Why sign up?

Pay about the same amount each month No bill fluctuations during months of hot/cold weather Makes it easier to manage your monthly expenses It's free – you pay only for the actual gas you use

Question: What Is Budget Billing?

Answer: PGA is now offering budget billing. This means you pay a set amount each month for your bill. PGA will look at the amount you spent last year and then add 10 percent, to cover the cost of inflation and divide the amount over twelve months.

Question: How will I pay the difference if the amount is figured incorrectly?

Answer: PGA will review your account quarterly to determine if the amount for budget billing was figured correctly. If your bill is higher/lower than anticipated, PGA will increase/decrease the monthly amount to spread out the difference over the remainder of the year. In May, your bill will reflect the amount to zero the account for the year.

If you choose to cancel Budget Billing, any amount you still owe will be due on your next bill. If we owe you, the amount will be credited to your account.

Eligibility requirements:

- Residential account
- No past due balances*
- Good payment history

*Note: Past due balances may be cause for removal from the program for a 12 month period.

Did you know?

You can combine PGA Budget Billing with automatic EFT payments from your checking or savings account.
